



Size and Format Requirements of Photo

For WWSC "Referee ID Card"

The photo submitted for use in the WWSC referee ID card must meet the following size and format requirements:

1. The photo's size must be a 2"x 2" (50mm x 50mm) square (see the sample below).



- 1. The photo has to be taken within the last six months and a passport color photo in front of plain white background. The photo should be a front view of the hat-free upper-body (shoulder and up) with facial features shown clearly.
- 2. While we recommend you use a professional passport photo service to ensure your photo meets all the requirements, you may take the photo yourself using a digital camera, a tablet, or a smart phone. The digital image produced must adhere to the following specifications: The image dimensions must be in a square aspect ratio (the height must be equal to the width). Minimum acceptable dimensions are 600 x 600 pixels. Maximum acceptable dimensions are 1200 x 1200 pixels. The preferred image format is JPEG.
- 3. If you create the photo image by scanning an existing passport photo, in addition to the requirement in No. 3 above for the resulting digital image, the existing photo to be scanned

must be in the size of 2×2 inches $(50 \times 50 \text{ mm})$. The scanning resolution has to be 300 pixels per inch (12 pixels/mm).

4. When naming your photo file, it is important to follow the format guidelines provided below to ensure proper organization and clarity.

"Referee ID Number_Referee Name", for example: "WWSC-G4-CR-00XXX_Ming_Wang".

Please note that if the photo you submitted does not meet the above requirements of size and format or if you fail to provide the information that we requested, the processing of your referee ID card may be delayed. Therefore, we ask and thank you for your cooperation!
